

Engineered to withstand Mother Nature, Sunbrella Horizon fabrics are long-lasting and resist the damaging effects of sun, rain, snow, and humidity.





Sunbrella Horizon is manufactured with highly UV-stable pigments, making them resistant to fading and the degrading effects of sunlight.




Mold & Mildew Resistant


3-Year Microbial Pink Staining Warranty

Sunbrella Horizon's industry-leading 3-year warranty protects against microbial pinking. See sunbrella.com for warranty details.

Any warranty claim in the first 3 years may be eligible for up to \$40 in labor costs per linear yard in addition to replacement product. Replacement costs pay for reupholstery and/or trim.

Fabrication Tips

APPLICATION	NEEDLE TYPE	THREAD SIZE (TEX)	NEEDLE SIZE	THREAD TYPE	STITCHES/INCH (SPI)
Marine/Outdoor	ROUND	70	20	Solution-Dyed Polyester	6-7
Marine/Outdoor	ROUND	90	20-22	Solution-Dyed Polyester	6-7
Marine/Outdoor	ROUND	90	16-20	PTFE	6
Furniture	ROUND	40-70	16-20	Nylon	6-8

Note: These are recommendations only. Many times, the needle size will vary depending on the type of machine used and the sewer.

Fabrication Tips

- Use solution-dyed polyester or PTFE thread.
- If needed, use a polyurethane-based adhesive.
- Diagonal stitching is recommended, without going over the needlework.
- Pattern and seam allowances should be considered.
- Seam tape is recommended.
- Polyurethane Foam: If used, foam should be new and treated to inhibit fungal growth to pass ASTM G-21 (CFFA - 120), ASTM E1428 and AATCC 147 (CFFA -300) standards.
- Plywood: If used, plywood should be treated to be mildew and rot resistant.
- To prevent moisture build-up, keep product and substructure ventilated.
- We DO NOT recommend using steam on Sunbrella Horizon to remove wrinkles and creases. Dry heat can be used. Always test a patch in an inconspicuous place.

Simple Care & Cleaning

Most messes can be wiped down using a clean, dry towel.

- Do not use abrasive cloths or cleaners as to avoid surface damage.
- For regular cleaning and maintenance, use a water-based solvent, isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol, or a non-abrasive cleaner.
- For stubborn spots, or to disinfect, use a bleach solution.
